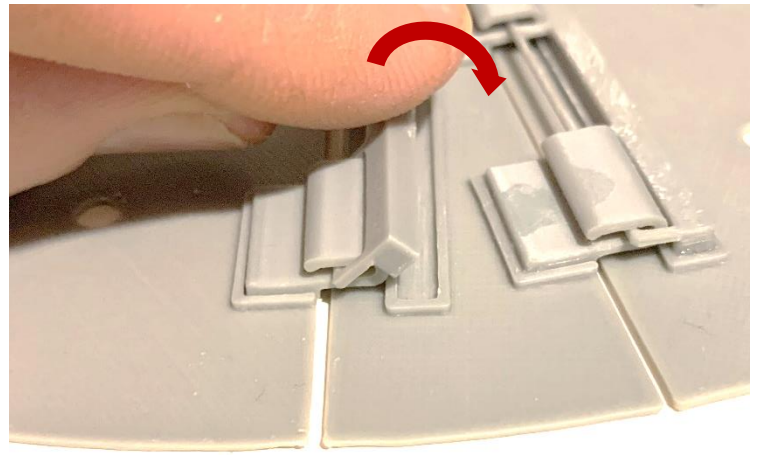
As each panel is installed, fold the end clip under the central section and align with panel tabs.
